Instructions for pupils sitting SQA examinations

1. **Exam leave for S4 pupils begins Wednesday 30th April.** Pupils returning to school the following session must report back on **Monday 2nd June at 8.35.**

Exam leave for S5/6 pupils begins Wednesday 14th May. Pupils returning to school must report back on **Thursday 5th June at 8.35.**

2. Each day, outside the Assembly Hall, there will be a copy of exam lists and times for the exams taking place that day. Seat numbers will also be displayed. **You must sit at the desk assigned to you.** Remember to make a note of your Scottish Candidate Number which appears on your SQA timetable – this number must be written on your examination papers.
3. Pupils who travel by school transport must do so, at the normal times, during the exam period. If your exam finishes after the normal school day, you will have to make your way home on public transport. Your money will be refunded to you, as long as you keep your bus tickets. If you decide to come to school later in the morning or finish earlier in the afternoon, you can do so but you will not be refunded for your bus tickets.

Pupils who are sitting an exam on either the 6th May or the 19th May must use public transport. Your money will be refunded to you when you hand in your bus tickets.

4. **Punctuality:** You must report to your exam room at least 10 minutes before your exam is due to begin. Do not enter the exam room until you are told to do so. If you are late for the examination, report to Reception immediately. Arrangements will be made to enable you to enter the examination room.
5. When entering or leaving the Examination Room, do so quietly. Remember to have some consideration for the other Candidates in the examination room. **DO NOT LOITER** outside the examination room after your examination is finished.
6. You must carry out any instructions issued by the invigilators. Once you enter the Examination room you, you must adhere to the rules of the Scottish Qualifications Authority – you **must** obey the invigilators.
7. Mobile phones are **not** allowed in the Examination room.
8. **You must wear school uniform, at all times, when in the school building.**

9. If exams fall out with the normal interval and lunch times, arrangements will be made to open the Dining Hall earlier or later.
10. Absence from an examination due to illness: if this happens, your parent/guardian must contact the school promptly and ask for the Business Manager, who will advise them on the procedure to be carried out.
11. I wish you all good luck! Remember – you **can** do it!
